



## ***The Arnold Palmer Signature Golf Course at Stonewall Resort***

Described by golfing legend Arnold Palmer as “a spectacle that everyone will enjoy”, the Arnold Palmer Signature Golf Course at Stonewall Resort, is one of the most enjoyable and challenging resort and public courses in the nation.

The course, which opened in 2002, has already received many top honors, including being named the #1 Public Access Course in West Virginia and #23 Best Resort Course in the Country by Golfweek (March 2007), #2 New Course in America in the Upscale Public Course Category by Golf Digest (January 2004), and one of the *Top 10 Courses You Can Play* by Golf Magazine (March 2003). Arnold Palmer himself named hole #17 to his all time favorite 18 list out of the courses he’s designed.

Measuring 7,149 yards from the back, or “Palmer” tees, the course boasts a United States Golf Association (USGA) Course Rating of 74.6 and a Slope Rating of 142.

While this may seem intimidating to some, the Palmer Course offers six separate tee placements. From the number four tee, which is the tee closest to the green for the men, the Slope Rating is much closer to the average at 123. This allows golfers of all abilities to choose their desired level of challenge.

However, golfers will want to play here as much for the scenery as for the challenge. The course is nestled beautifully into the natural landscape and is one where gently sloping hills fall into long, lush valleys perfect for long drives. The front nine holes not only border Stonewall Jackson Lake, but incorporate it into the layout.

The Adirondack-styled Golf Shop, which sits on the highest point of the resort property and provides panoramic views of the area, offers guests the traditional amenities found in a golf course clubhouse – pro shop, locker facilities, tournament staging areas, lounge and restaurant. Adjacent to the clubhouse, the tiered driving range offers multiple natural and artificial tee box surfaces for practice or warm-up before a round.

Golf rates for the 2007 season include 18-holes with cart and driving range privileges and are \$75 Monday – Thursday and \$89 Friday – Sunday.
