E.H. Taylor, Jr. Small Batch

Made by hand, this Small Batch Bourbon Whiskey has been aged inside century old warehouses constructed by E.H. Taylor, Jr. This gold medal winning bourbon is a true sipping bourbon that honors the uncompromising legacy of E.H. Taylor, Jr.

Knob Creek 2001 Limited Edition 2001 (Batch 4)

This limited edition bourbon came from a special batch barreled by the master distiller Booker Noe before his death. It is aged for 14 years, which is longer than most whiskeys, giving it a full, rich body and unparalleled flavor.

Woodford Reserve Double Oaked

An innovative approach to twice-barreled bourbon creates the rich and colorful flavor of Woodford Reserve Double Oaked. This bourbon is uniquely matured in separate, charred oak barrels extracting additional amounts of soft, sweet oak character.

Eagle Rare

Eagle Rare Bourbon Whiskey is masterfully crafted and carefully aged for no less than ten years. Every barrel is discriminately selected to offer consistent flavor but with a seemingly individual personality.

Basil Hayden's
