Explore the Stone Cairns! A 150-foot section of wall runs parallel to the Cairns Trail. Local historians and archeologists claim that the structures do not fit the pattern of fortification structures, ruling out the possibility of Civil War soldiers constructing them. Some believe that they were created by Native Americans, while others link them to early European settlers. The Cairns' origins and purpose remain a mystery.
